

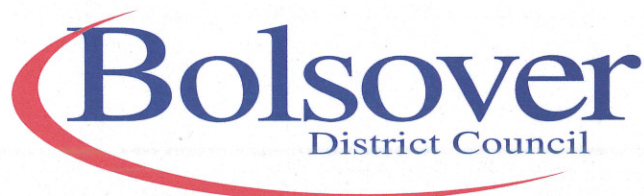
LATE SCOPING CONSULTATION RESPONSES


